


# Counseling Tutoring Study Hall

Excellent academic achievement is a goal standard at Cathedral School. However, we also recognize that students may need extra time, extra help, or other support to reach their highest potential, therefore, we offer study hall, tutoring, and counseling when we can.



#### Study Hall

There will be a Study Hall available the four days of Exploratory Classes for Middle School students. They will be allowed to take one study hall per semester unless the middle school teachers suggest that a particular student could benefit from taking more than two a year.

We will make Study Hall mandatory for the students who are failing any academic courses to give them time and the help they need to succeed.

#### Tutoring

Cathedral teachers try to meet the needs of every student, but sometimes more is needed. Through volunteers and staffing we are able to offer some levels of tutoring. The School District of Superior also has Title I for students that meet their criteria and can then offer extra help in math and reading.



#### Counseling

Cathedral school has a part time guidance counselor on staff. The guidance counselor helps the students deal with academic, social, and personal issues that interfere with their learning. Students work one-on-one and in small and large groups with the counselor to address developmental concerns. The guidance counselor also works with teachers and parents to address the students' needs. She keeps track of students' progress and develops Individual Catholic Educational Plans for students who need accommodations or modifications to improve their learning. She teaches developmental guidance lessons at the elementary level and at the Middle School level she teaches Exploratory Classes that deal with teens' issues.
