Christmas Concert Dress Code



The Cathedral School Elementary and Preschool Christmas Concerts are Thursday, December 20th in the Annabring gymnasium. Pre-School will be held at 10:00 a.m. and Kindergarten thru 5th will be at 1:00 p.m. The uniform policy for that day is uniform clothes or dress clothes for grades K-5th. You **can not** wear shorts, jeans, t-shirts, or sweatshirts. No spaghetti straps or tank tops. Shoulders must be covered at all times.

Middle School and 5th grade band will be held on Wednesday December 19th 6:00 p.m. in Cathedral Church.
(Students Need to Arrive by 5:30pm)

Dress Code: The evening of the concert, students must meet the requirements of Catholic modesty and neatness, respect for self, and respect for one another. This dress code has been developed to help ensure the safety and overall well-being of students.

- Boys: black dress pants, a white dress shirt (button-down or polo), and black or dark-colored shoes, ties are optional.
- Girls: black dress pants or skirt (must be knee length or longer), a white dress shirt (must have a modest neckline), black or dark-colored shoes.
- *Tank tops, spaghetti strap, shirts, or clothing that expose the shoulders, midriff, back, or undergarments will not be allowed. An additional top, like a jacket or sweater (also colored white) can be worn to cover the shoulders at all times.

* Heels cannot be higher than two inches, due to safety concerns. No flip flops.
