Student Illness

Your child must remain home if he or she displays symptoms of illness including but not limited to fever of 100 or greater, sore throat (24 hours after starting antibiotics), diarrhea(24 hours), vomiting (24 hours), lethargy, skin rash, eye infection. If a student is not able to carry on the normal activities of the classroom or school, then the student should not be in school.
