Dear Cathedral Families,

I pray everyone is enjoying quality family time during our Spring Break. As we continue to monitor the constantly evolving and changing COVID-19 situation, we at Cathedral continue to pray for those impacted by the virus. Now more than ever, it is vital to take care of our family and our friends; and take time out of our day for prayer.

In response to Cathedral's Plan for Extended Closure of School, our teaching staff has been diligently working to organize and create lesson plans for all our students, 3-year-old Pre-School through Middle School. Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, March 18, 2020, at 11:30 a.m. the school will be open for families to pick up their child(ren)'s class work, books, etc. until 5:00 p.m.

Upon entering the building, your child(ren)'s class work may be found in lockers for Pre-School students, in cubbies for Elementary students, and outside of lockers for Middle School students. If your child has a band instrument at school, we ask that their instrument goes home as well. Please remember to stop by the office to pick up your child's medication. We are requesting that everyone entering the building does so quickly and efficiently.

Regarding distance learning, Cathedral classes officially resume Monday, March 23, 2020. Class instruction and communication will be different for each age group. Some of our students will be completing work from teacher created learning packets, while other students will be fulfilling their learning targets using Google Classroom. Each teacher will facilitate the distance learning of their class. Teachers will be providing information about student expectations in the days ahead so at-home distance learning can be successful.

Communication from Cathedral School will be via OptionC Parent Alerts. Additional information and updates may be found on our school website. Individual class communication will be as follows:

- Pre-School, Kindergarten, and Grades 1 & 2

Teachers will communicate with parents and students via Class Dojo and email

- Grades 3, 4, & 5

Teachers will communicate with parents via Class Dojo, and at times with students via Google Classroom

- Middle School – Grades 6, 7, & 8

Teachers will communicate with parents via OptionC email, and with students via Google Classroom

We understand some our Cathedral families are out of town or unable to collect their child(ren)'s class work and belongings tomorrow, we are asking those families to contact the school at (715) 392-2976 to set up a pick up time.

If you have questions or need support, please contact your child(ren)'s teacher(s) via email or Class Dojo. To contact the school for any other concerns, please be sure to leave a voicemail at (715) 392-2976 and your call will be returned as soon as possible. Our system will be routing these voicemails directly to school administration.

We ask for continual prayers as we navigate through this distance learning continuum for the extended future.
