

## THREE CLASSROOMS UPDATED

This summer we were able to update the Kindergarten, First and Second Grade rooms due to the generosity of our Cathedral School Alumni! We will continue to update classrooms as donations allow.

Built in 1950-1951, the school has served our community for 65 years. During that time, the budget has only allowed for routine interior maintenance.

The updated classrooms are bright with updated energy efficient lighting, new ceiling tiles, new flooring and a fresh coat of paint.

### COSTS PER CLASSROOM

The Interior Renewal Project will address each of the 30 classrooms and offices. They will be equipped with energy efficient lighting, new teaching surfaces and technology, reface the cupboards, install new flooring, doors, and paint.




