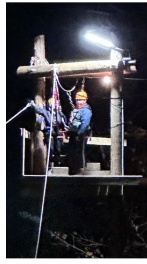


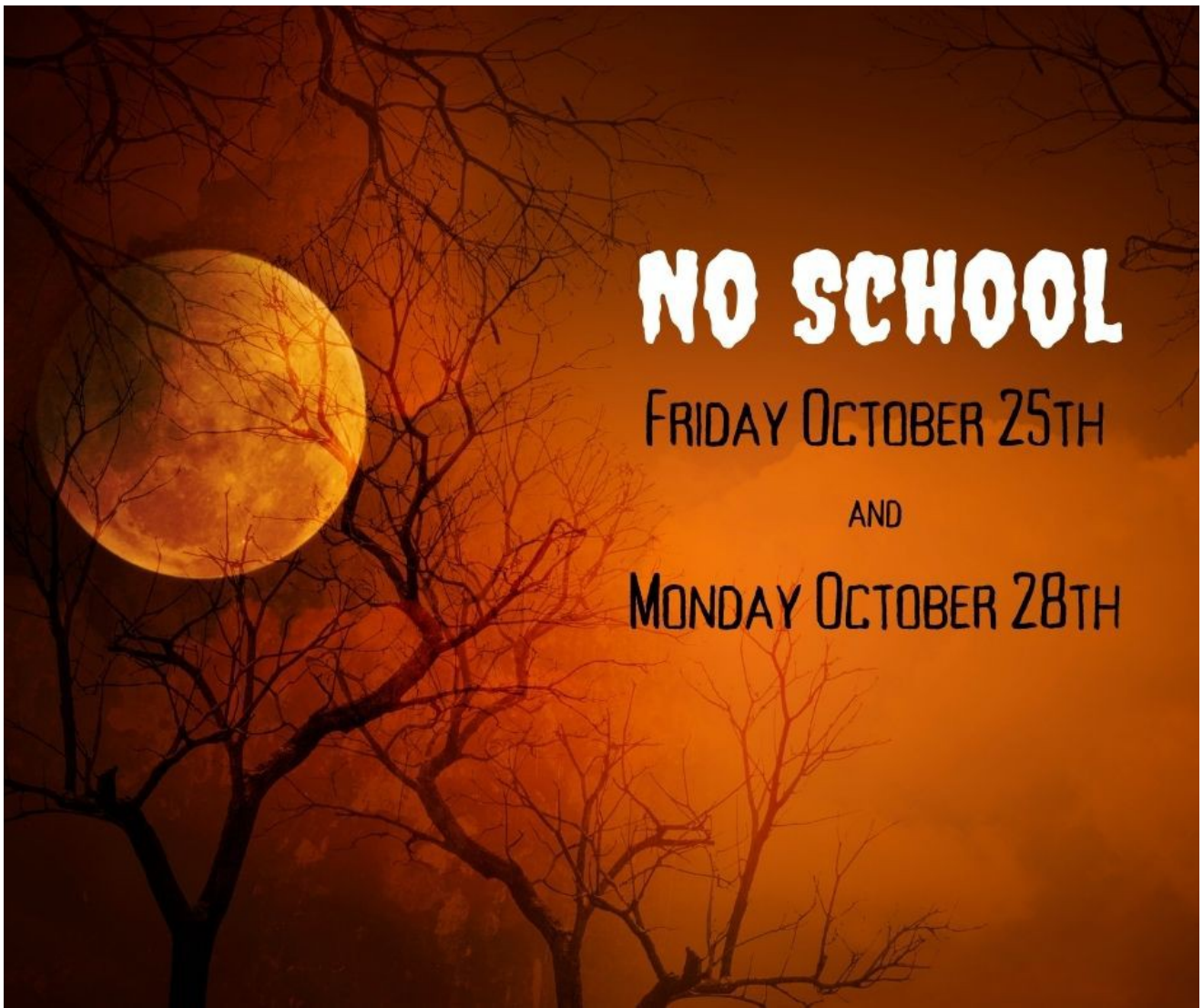

Drop Off and Pick Up

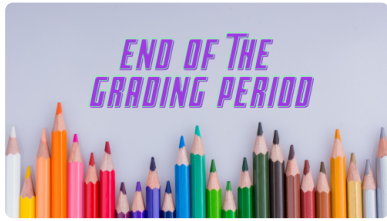
Student Pick-Up and Drop Off:

We want all the students attending Cathedral School to be able to get into and out of the building safely. We ask that you please take note of our pick up/ drop off procedure.

Parking

- Please refrain from parking in the staff and faculty parking lot. We have staff that comes and goes throughout the day.
- **NO parking or stopping your car in the cross walk or fire lane.**
- **The alley is NOT a drop off spot for a student.** It is better to park along the sidewalk and let the student(s) out. Traffic can build up behind you, when using the alley and become dangerous for students trying to cross the alley. Staff is also trying to park in the lot and this can cause a lot of unwanted congestion.
- 14th Street "bus zone" cannot be used to pick up or drop off students. This door needs to remain clear so buses can pull in to drop off and pick up students.
- At the end of the day it is again better to park your car along the sidewalk and have your child walk to you or you walk to the front entrance to pick your child up.
- The church parking lot is often over looked. Please use this lot as well for dropping off and picking up students. Baxter can fill up quickly before and after school.

- We know that this is inconvenient but we are looking out for everybody's safety. We looking into what we can do to make this better for everyone.

Halloween Dress Code
