CATHEDRAL CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN

Dear Friends,

Catholic Education has a long and rich tradition in our city, and Cathedral School has provided this treasure for over 70 years, thanks to the generosity and support of many who came before us. In a special way, Cathedral parishioners have made tremendous sacrifices for the School, specifically in recent history. This includes the \$2 million dollar capital campaign in 2013 which restored all the exterior masonry and replaced glass block and original windows with a high efficiency system. Point: **The Cathedral parish loves their school and shows it with their financial support.**

Now, the Cathedral parish is undertaking another historic campaign, this time to take care of essential upgrades in anticipation of the 100th anniversary of the church in 2027. Projects include:

- Redo Parking Lot and Concrete Work
- Revamp Interior Lighting
- Repair, Reseal and Restore Exterior Stone Work
- Upgrade Sound and Video Systems
- Update Elevator Operating System
- Overhaul Air Conditioning System
- Replace Clay Roof Tiles

This work is crucial for our kids. Every day Cathedral School students pass through the tunnel into the Cathedral for things like weekly Mass, daily lunch, prayer activities, retreats, sacraments, or band. Parents and grandparents attend these events, and our improvements to the safety and access of the Cathedral have a direct benefit for our School.

The Cathedral parish is firmly committed to the campaign; to date we have raised \$1.6 of our \$2.1 million goal. **I ask that you prayerfully consider helping us so that we can take of the Cathedral so she can continue to take care of our kids.**

CLASSROOM IMPROVEMENTS UPDATE

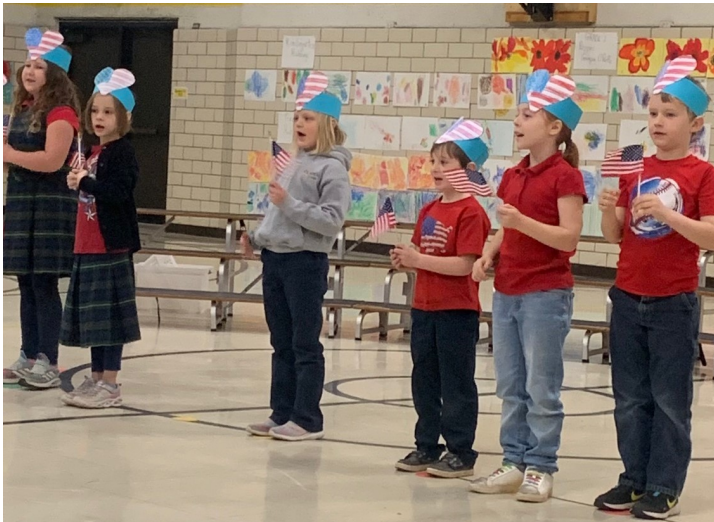
Through the generosity of Cathedral School alumni, we have been able to renovate sixteen classrooms over the past few years! Each classroom is equipped with new lighting, flooring, countertops, cabinet facing, paint, and SMART Boards or SMART Projectors.

Over the summer we updated the lighting in the remaining Middle School Classrooms in order to utilize a Focus on Energy Grant. We also installed countertops for the remaining classrooms.

We look forward to finishing the computer lab and the Barbara J. Milroy Science Lab next summer.

Going forward we will be increasing access points for our 1:1 technology, continuing to upgrade technology, and continuing to work on the infrastructure. The needs of a 70 year old school are always present!

Cathedral School Endowment Fund

This is an Endowment Fund. The purpose of the Cathedral School Endowment Fund is restricted to the long term financial support of the Cathedral School's operational needs. Monies from this Fund may be withdrawn through the Cathedral School's annual process or as determined by the Rector with the advice and input from the Principal and the Finance Council.

Cathedral School: Tuition Assistance Fund

The purpose of this Tuition Assistance Fund is to offer financial relief to families who desire to send their children to Cathedral School and require assistance with the cost of tuition. This Fund is specifically restricted to tuition assistance, and is expended at the discretion of the Principal of Cathedral School with the prior consent of the Rector.

Cathedral School: Technology Fund

The purpose of the Technology Fund is restricted to support the technology resources utilized at Cathedral School. This includes technology infrastructure and updating resources such as computers, laptops, tablets, smart boards, and interactive digital technology. Monies from this Fund are authorized by the Principal and can be expended through the annual budget process or by the Rector.

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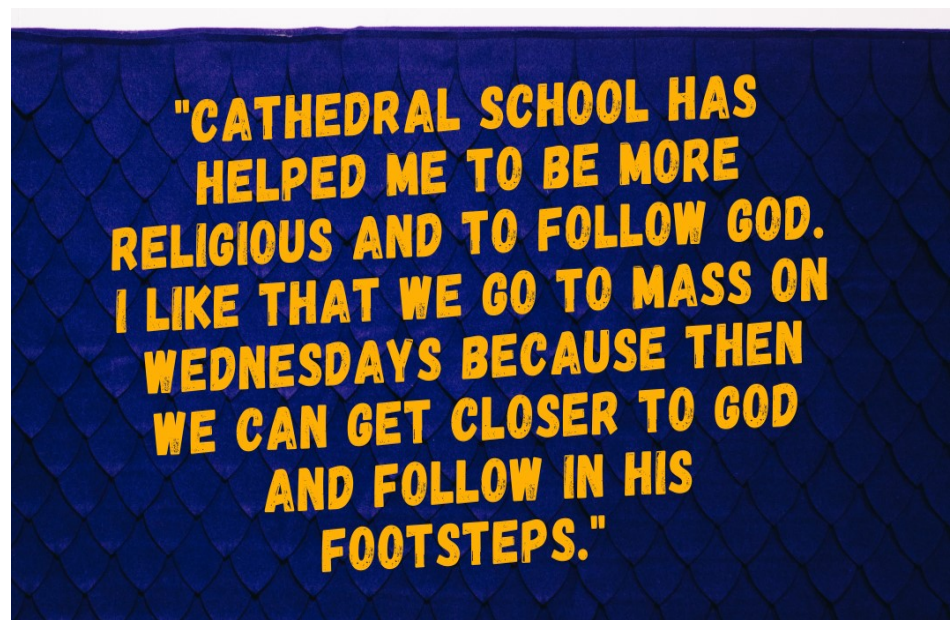
